New Service!

In-Season Training

We are thrilled to offer a brand new service for 2010: In-Season Training. Our In-Season Training program will consist of a 2-day weekend session of intensive baseball instruction at two critical points in the season:

1. *Pre-Season Tune-Up*: May 1-2 from 9am to 3:30pm
2. *Pre-Tryout Tune-Up*: Sept. 11-12 from 9am to 3:30pm

Location: Sentinel Park (at Keele St. & Sheppard Ave.)

Our expert instruction will focus on reviewing the fundamentals and providing a high volume of repetitions. Instructors will stress the skills necessary to perform at a high level during the season and the skills that coaches look for during tryouts. For more information, please visit our website.

Join our Staff

We are looking to expand our team of Counselors and CITs.

Counselors:

Counselors will be full-time staff at Main Camp or Elite Camp. Responsibilities will include leading a camper Skill Group, instructing, and supervision of campers. Counselors will be chosen based on baseball experience, camp counselor experience, and ability to instruct. Must be 16 as of December 31st, 2010 to apply.

Counselor-in-Training (CIT) Program

CITs will be hired for 2-week sessions at Main Camp or Elite Camp. Responsibilities will include demonstrating drills, assisting Counselors, and supervision of campers. There is no fee to enroll and no salary. Must be 15 as of December 31st 2010 to apply.



Online Registration

Due to several shortfalls with our previous online enrollment system, we have partnered up with *CampRegister*, an extremely user-friendly online enrollment tool! Not comfortable with the computer? You can still fill out our application and mail or fax it in. Your choice!

Note about Harmonized Sales Tax

As you may know, a 13% Harmonized Sales Tax (HST) is being introduced as of July 1st, 2010. The HST will apply to fees paid for services provided on or after July 1st. As a result, our registration fees will be subject to 13% HST as opposed to the 5% GST charged in previous years. In an effort to keep our rates at a reasonable level, we have not increased our base registration fees for the upcoming season. Thanks!
